Abington LTC Risk Assessment

Entrance Area - Standard size gate and very low angle ramp presents no risk.

Cabin Area – Commercially available cabin from a major supplier so should present no risk. There are steps onto the veranda area but these are clearly visible as the area is raised. The cabin interior contains tables and chairs which are neatly stowed around the edges of the room.

Court Access – Two full doorway sized entrances to the courts with soft curtains hanging to prevent balls escaping present no risk.

Court Area – The courts are grass which can become slippery in certain conditions. There are signs in the cabin explaining the risk and that players must decide themselves if the courts are safe to play on. Club members are experienced in making this decision. Players should not crash into the surround fencing during play as it is not designed for impact with people only to contain tennis balls.

Light Conditions; When the light is poor take additional care both on court and when moving around the premises.

Smoking - The whole premises is a no smoking area

First aid kit is in the cabin on the right as you enter

Fire Extinguisher – There is a fire extinguisher in the cabin

Children - Visiting children are not to be left unsupervised
